They also organize networks of law enforcement personnel and subject matter specialists in many criminal justice fields who meet together through working groups and conferences to exchange knowledge and ideas.

The three main priorities for Interpol are terrorist activity, crimes involving people, and crimes over property. Including human trafficking, terrorism, drug trafficking, and cybercrime, Interpol works assiduously to encourage international cooperation in resolving these serious problems.

These \$70 - 200 million dollars inflate the economy, which makes real money less valuable. This is why governments implement security features in banknotes such as the quality of the paper, different inks, watermarks, etc. All these measures ensure that it is harder to counterfeit money and counterfeit money is easier to spot. The plastic to make money is also not public, making it harder for counterfeiters to get a similar material.

Before most of these measures, circulating counterfeited currency into the enemy's economy was used as a warfare technique. This would cause mass inflation, breaking down the economy. Criminal activities like these use weaknesses and loopholes in the financial system, making responding with new policies complex. The "Panama Papers" are a good example of this, where 11.5 million confidential documents were leaked. This exposed over 214,000 tax havens that involved high-profile individuals, including government officials and entities from over 200 nations.

#### **CURRENT SITUATION OF THE TOPIC**

In fiscal 2022–2023, counterfeit Rs. 1000 notes significantly increased despite a little decline in the overall amount of false notes discovered year over year. According to Reserve Bank of India (RBI) data, the number of fake Rs. 1000 notes has surged 44 times from just eleven a year ago to 482.
